THE LAND

Plots in Baños de Ebro, Laguardia and San Vicente de la Sonsierra, with vines planted on soil with widely varying geological and edaphological characteristics. Limestone, gravel and clay all combine in this unusual balance of poor soil and a climate marked by sharp contrasts. 25- to 70-year-old sustainably cultivated goblet-trained and unirrigated vines.

PRODUCTION

We are mere transmitters that seek to give the utmost respect to natural fermentation processes through measured intervention, in order to create an authentic wine that reflects its place of origin.

The grapes are fermented in 20,000 kg vats, classified by soil type, using a selection of our native yeasts. The *assemblage* of these wines are aged for 14 months.

Ageing: 14 months in 225- and 500-litre French oak casks and concrete tanks.

TASTING NOTES

This is a wine with a bright, clean cherry colour.

Elegant ripe red and black forest fruit aromas on a well-structured background of oak notes.

It is well-balanced on the palate, with a good body, well-rounded tannins and a long finish.

Recommended serving temperature: 16°C

Recommended glass: Riedel Veritas New World Shiraz or similar



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
